ESIC Hospital Peenya Bangalore -560022

A 80 year old male Mr. Krishnamurthy presented to our hospital with complaints of pain abdomen. He was diagnosed to have hiatus hernia and was planned for Nissen-Rossetti fundoplication under the guidance of Medical superintendent Dr. VeenaKumari madam, Oncosurgeon Dr. Anup T.S., Anaesthetist Dr. Jayaprakash S under general anaesthesia and invasive monitor (CVP line) on 19th November 2024. Blood, blood products and intercostal drain were kept ready preoperatively. As the surgery proceeded with mobilization of esophagus from the mediastinum patient had episodes of arrhythmia associated with hemodynamic instability which reverted spontaneously. Patient withstood the procedure well and was shifted to the ICU for postoperative care. With an excellent ICU care patient recovered well in the icu with adequate pain management, total parenteral nutrition, and early ambulation on the second postoperative day. He was discharged on the 8th postoperative day.
